"The sentence down here (pointing to the first printed sentence) tells what is happening in the picture. I am going to point to each word as I read; then I want you to point to each word as you read." (The educator finger-point reads the sentence.) "Now it's your turn."

(If necessary, the educator moves the student's finger to the first word. "Katie", to help him/her get started).

Procedure:

- Educator moves to the second, third, and fourth sentences, repeating the same procedure on each page.
